



Job Fair proslavio svoj 15. rođendan obaranjem svih rekorda!

Kako je obilježen ovogodišnji 15. rođendan najvećeg sajma poslova u Hrvatskoj?

U srijedu i četvrtak, **11. i 12. svibnja**, održao se **15. Job Fair**. Sportska dvorana Martinovka na ta dva dana zamijenila je svoju primarnu ulogu i postala mjesto susreta **134 poduzeća** iz **15 različitih industrija** i preko **5 tisuća studenata** STEM usmjerenja.

Bogati program u Martinovki

Cjelodnevni program uključivao je **129 štandova** koje su studenti mogli posjetiti, a veliki dio njih imao je i svoje dodatne aktivnosti u kojima su studenti mogli sudjelovati, npr. isprobati modernu tehnologiju poput VR naočala, natjecati se u zagonetkama ili iskušati svoju sreću u raznim igrama i osvojiti zanimljive poklone. Na pozornici se za to vrijeme također odvijao poseban program. Predstavnici poduzeća razgovarali su o svojim iskustvima kroz **24 talka** podijeljena u **tri kategorije**: *Career Switch*, *What the Tech?! i Recycled Technology*. U sredini prvog dana program je upotpunjen **panel raspravom** na temu "Kako umjetna inteligencija utječe na naše društvo?" u kojoj su predstavnici iz gospodarske i akademske zajednice otkrili kako je umjetna inteligencija nastala, kako je oni primjenjuju, koji su njeni benefit i što nas čeka u budućnosti tijekom njenog razvoja. Drugi dan je program začinjen vrućim razgovorom poznatijem kao **Hot talk** u kojem je sudjelovao **Luka Drezga, COO iz Ars Future** koji je odgovarao na pitanja iz službene i neslužbene sfere života pritom probavajući jednako ljute umake. Svoju pobjedu odnio je ponosno osvajanjem najvećeg broja bodova do sada.

Dio sajma i na FER-u

Aktivnosti je bilo i na **Fakultetu elektrotehnike i računarstva** gdje se održalo čak **16 radionica** koje je ukupno posjetilo preko **300 studenata**. Tako su se predstavnici poduzeća i studenti mogli dotaknuti praktičnih zadataka i zajedničkim snagama riješiti rijeđi problem, ali i čuti razna iskustva ljudi iz industrije.

Dobra zabava u KSET-u

Na kraju prvog dana, predstavnici poduzeća i studenti zabavili su se na **Loosen up partiju** u **Klubu studenata elektrotehnike**. Večernje druženje uključilo je ekipno natjecanje u raznim igrama koje su zahtijevale poznavanja stranih jezika, filmova i glazbe, ali i fizičke spremu. Studenti su tako mogli u ležernijem okruženju



upoznati svoje buduće kolege koji su studente počastili s čak 14 vrsta besplatnih koktela i 9 vrsta točenih piva.

Događaj je popratilo 20 različitih medijskih kuća, a podržalo 4 prijatelja sajma. Tijekom pripreme sajma kroz pola godine, održano je preko 20 sastanaka organizacijskog tima i razmijenilo preko 20 tisuća poruka na Slacku. Job Fair celebrated its 15th birthday by breaking all records!

How was the 15th birthday of the largest job fair in Croatia celebrated?

On Wednesday and Thursday, **May 11 and 12**, the **15th Job Fair** took place. Martinovka Sports Hall switched its primary role those two days and became a meeting spot for **134 companies** from **15 different industries** and **over 5 thousand** STEM students.

A rich program at Martinovka

The whole-day program included 129 booths which students could visit and a big part of them had their own additional activities in which students could participate, such as try out modern technologies such as VR headsets, compete in riddles or try out their luck in different games and win interesting gifts. A special program took place on the stage at the same time. Company representatives talked about their experience in **24 talks** divided into **3 categories**: *Career Switch*, *What the Tech?! i Recycled Technology*. The first day was completed as a whole with a midday **panel discussion** about "How does artificial intelligence impact our society?" in which representatives from the economy and academic community found out how artificial intelligence came to be, how they use it, what the benefits are and what we can expect from the future. The second day got spicy with an interview better known as **Hot talk** in which **Luka Drezga, COO at Ars Futura** participated by answering questions about the work and home parts of life, all while trying out hot sauces. His victory is proudly marked with the highest score.

Part of the fair at FER

Activities continued over at the **Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing** where **16 workshops** with over 300 student participants took place. This gave company representatives and students an opportunity to together try to solve practical problems and learn from experienced individuals from the industry.

Good fun at KSET

At the end of the first day, company representatives and students had fun at the **Loosen up party** at the **Club of Students of Electrical Engineering**. The night's socializing included competing in teams at different games which required knowledge of foreign languages, films and music, but also physical fitness. This



allowed students to meet their future colleagues in a more casual environment, sipping on 14 different types of cocktail and 9 different kinds of deer, for free.

Miscellaneous

The event was reported on by 20 media houses, and supported by 4 friends of the Fair. Preparations took half a year, over 20 meetings of the organization board took place and over 20 0000 messages were sent on Slack. The Fair was visited by President Zoran Milanović, advisor for the President for education, Mrs Jadranka Žarković, special advisor for the President for the climate and energy, Mr Julije Domac, the director of the Administration for science and technology in the Ministry of science and education, Mr Hrvoje Meštrić, deputy mayor of the City of Zagreb, Mr Luka Korlaet and the Fair's host, dean of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing, Mr Gordan Gledec.
